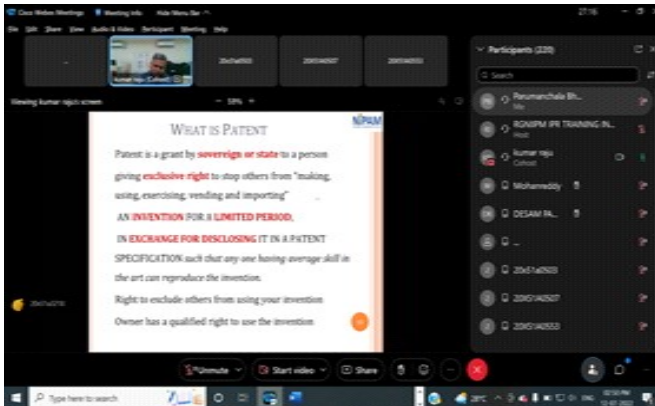

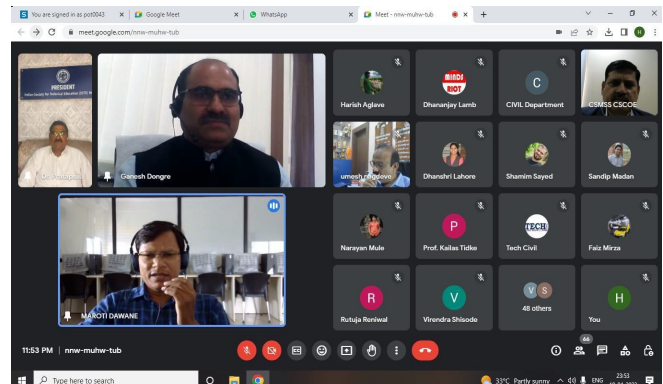
Exposure Trip by the final year students at a glance.

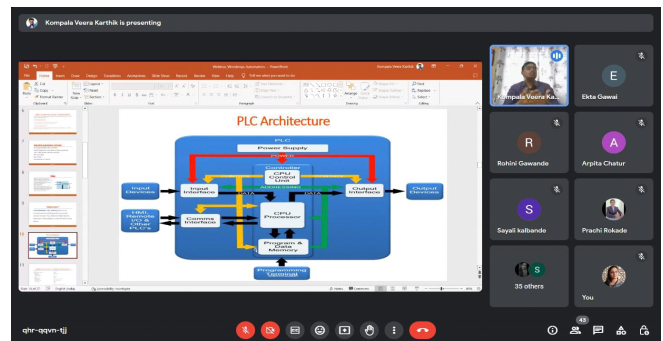
### MAHARASHTRA

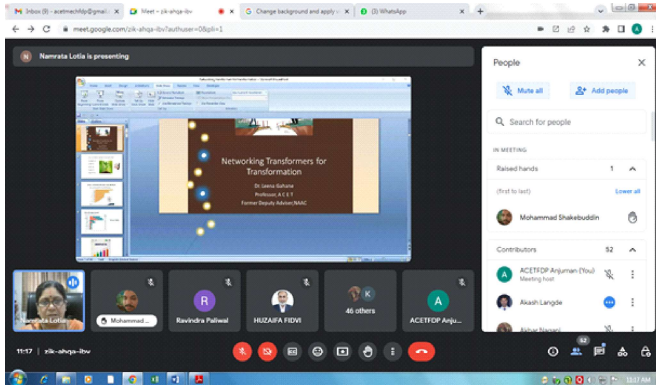
